

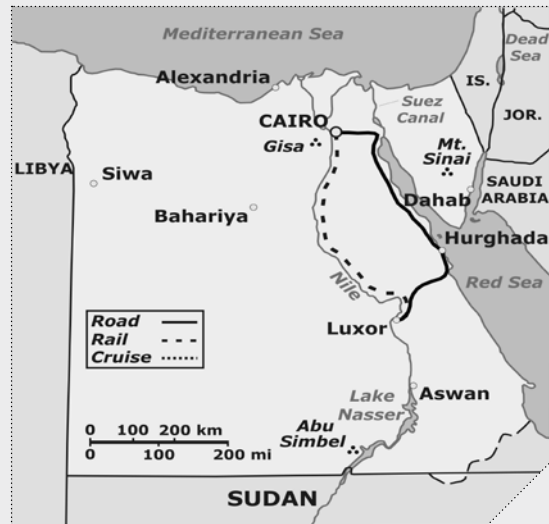

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DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1 / ARRIVE IN CAIRO

You arrive at Cairo airport where we greet and transfer you to your 5-star hotel. Our Egypt Uncovered rep. welcomes you, helps you settle into the hotel, and outlines the plan for the next few days.

Overnight at 5-star hotel in Cairo.

DAY 2 / CAIRO, TOUR TO PYRAMIDS, SPHINX AND MUSEUM

After breakfast we have a short pre-tour briefing before we take you on a tour of the pyramids & sphinx at Giza. Giza was built around 4600 years ago as a necropolis (cemetery) for the pharaoh Khufu (Cheops). The successor of Sneferu, Khufu was known as a tyrant and in his arrogance decided to have built a tomb that was bigger and better than all others. At 500 feet high and 750 feet wide at its base the Pyramid of Khufu is an awesome man-made structure constructed of giant stone blocks with a hard limestone casing. The casing has, over the years, been stripped away to leave exposed the inner block structure. Together with the smaller pyramids of Khafre (Chephern) and Menkaure (Mycerinus), the majestic sight of these enormous structures rising out of the desert is a breathtaking spectacle.

Here you have the chance to climb inside one of the pyramids (there are a limited number of tickets available in the Great Pyramid, so we cannot guarantee entry), and also to take a camel ride (approx. £2-5 p/p for around 30mins).

Close by, the mysterious Sphinx stands guard, as it has done so for thousands of years. You have another guided tour around the sphinx and some free time to walk around and take photos.

From here we take you back to the centre of Cairo to visit the Egyptian Museum, one of the world's most famous museums. The museum houses a vast collection of artefacts from Egypt's past, including the famous King Tutankhamun display.

At the end of the day we transfer you to the station for an overnight sleeper train to Luxor (approx. 20.40-05.45)

Overnight in cabin on sleeper train (B D).

DAY 2 EXTRA OPTIONS

Cairo to Luxor flight option

DAY 3 / LUXOR, WEST BANK

The town of Luxor is built on and around the ancient site of Thebes, and boasts the largest concentration of ancient ruins in the Nile Valley, if not the world. To the West of the Nile lies the City of the Dead, with its mortuary temples and rock-hewn tombs, whilst to the east lie the Temples of Luxor & Karnak.

After our early morning arrival, we take a tour to the West Bank of the Nile, starting with the Valley of the Kings where you will see several of the elaborately painted underground tombs in which the Pharaohs and their Queens were buried. Your guide will choose the best tombs open during your visit (the entry ticket covers 3 tombs – extra visits are available to the tombs of Tutankhamun and Ramses V & VI for an extra fee paid locally). Arriving here early avoids the biggest crowds and the extreme heat in the middle of the day (also, our hotel rooms will not be ready to check into yet).

Next we take you to visit the unique three-tiered Mortuary Temple of Queen Hatchepsut. Dedicated to the God Amun this temple complex framed by towering cliffs is a wondrous sight. We then visit Medinat Habu, a temple of Ramses III, which is not on most tourist itineraries, but has some of the very deepest carved hieroglyphs, and the best preserved coloured wall paintings, really giving you an idea of how these Egyptian temples looked in their prime.

Finally you will stop to see the Colossi of Memnon, two huge 50 feet high statues of King Amenhotep II, before returning to check into your 5-star hotel by the Nile. The afternoon is free for you to relax or explore Luxor.

Overnight at 5-star hotel in Luxor (B).

DAY 4 / LUXOR, EAST BANK

Today's half-day tour is to the East Bank of Luxor. Your tour will include a visit to the Temple of Luxor, and the huge temple complex at Karnak. The great Temple of Amun at Karnak was once the religious centre of Thebes and Upper Egypt. It was linked to Luxor by an extensive avenue, which was lined with sphinxes, and the whole complex was in turn linked to the Nile via a canal through which moved the sacred boats of the god Amun. Entering through a smaller sphinx-lined avenue, built by Ramesses II, you come to the immense pylon entrance. Inside the huge Courtyard are three chapels dedicated to the gods Amun, Khous and Mut. The remarkable Hypostyle Hall has 134 towering columns, each carved with scenes of gods and pharaohs, and hieroglyphic inscriptions adorn the walls. Lying 3 km to the south of Karnak in the centre of town, the Temple of Luxor was built by Amenophis III and later enlarged by Ramses II. The partially damaged statues inside all represent Ramses II, and it was he who built the colonnaded forecourt. The Colonnade and Court of Amenophis III are perhaps the most striking parts of the temple.

The rest of your time today is free for you to relax in the hotel or explore Luxor.

Overnight at 5-star hotel in Luxor (B).

DAY 5 / LUXOR, FREE DAY. DRIVE TO HURGHADA

Your day is free in Luxor for you to relax or do some more sightseeing.

There is a lot to see in and around Luxor, and you can arrange more sightseeing tours with your guide and our reps if you wish (e.g. the Ramesseum, or the tombs in the Valley of the Nobles, or Valley of the Queens). Alternatively, you can relax in the hotel, explore the bazaars and streets in town, visit the Luxor museum, take a camel or horse ride along the Nile or into the desert, or take a felucca sailboat trip on the Nile.

There is an option for an early morning hot-air balloon flight today.

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We leave Luxor in the afternoon for the drive to our Red Sea Resort in Hurghada (approx. 4 ½ hours).

Overnight in Red Sea resort (B D).

DAY 5 EXTRA OPTIONS

Hot air balloon option

DAY 6-7 / RED SEA RIVIERA

You now have the whole of the next two days free to relax and enjoy Egypt's most popular Red Sea beach resort. The beautiful, sandy beaches and crystal blue waters make Hurghada the ideal place to relax and sunbathe, but for the more active there is plenty to do to keep busy. Some of the best diving and snorkelling in the world can be found around Hurghada, but if you would rather stay dry then try a glass bottom boat ride to view the spectacular, nearby coral reefs. Maybe a jeep safari or camel ride into the desert is more to your taste, or an excursion to the nearby monasteries of St Paul and St Anthony. You can choose to do as much or as little as you want in Hurghada and your resort or our reps will help to arrange everything for you during your stay.

Your time in the resort is on a half-board basis.

Overnight in Red Sea resort (2xB, 2xD).

DAY 8 RED SEA RESORT. DRIVE TO CAIRO

You have a free morning in Hurghada today, before we head north, following the Red Sea Coast to the Suez Canal, and back to Cairo (approx. 6 hour drive). It is possible to start your international flight journey home from Hurghada if you wish, though a stop-off in Cairo will be required en-route.

In the evening you board a river steamer for dinner on the Nile. You will enjoy the unique taste of Middle Eastern cuisine whilst experiencing traditional Egyptian Sufi and Belly Dancing.

Overnight at 5-star hotel in Cairo (B D).

DAY 8 EXTRA OPTIONS

Hurghada to Cairo flight option

Al Fayoum & Valley of the Whales option

DAY 9 TOUR ENDS

Your tour ends after breakfast and your time is free until we transfer you to the airport for your flight home. (B).

SMALL GROUP, PRIVATE AND TAILOR-MADE TOURS

SMALL GROUP DEPARTURES:

We have regular small group departures on this tour throughout the year. Departure dates are given on our website, and on request.

PRIVATE DEPARTURES:

You can also choose to do the tour privately, following the itinerary above, but on any other date. We add a small supplement for these departures. Please contact us first to check availability.

TAILOR-MADE TOURS:

This tour can also be used as a base for a private tailor-made itinerary, to be run on any dates. You can make adjustments as per your own requirements (for example, adding extra days, slightly shortening the tour, adding a scuba-diving course etc.).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

OPTIONS:

Booking and paying for options:

Options are split into two types

A - Those that must be booked in advance (mainly accommodation based). Prices for these are set in GB Pounds and must be booked and paid for in advance of your arrival.

B - Those that may be arranged in Egypt (eg. hot air balloon flights, extra city tours, sound & light shows etc.). Prices for these are set in Egyptian Pounds, and they are paid for while you are in Egypt. This gives you more flexibility and means you won't lose out if you were to book an option in advance and then not do it.

A - ADVANCE BOOKING OPTIONS

These may be booked by selecting them on our online reservation form, and can also be added after you have made your booking, subject to availability at the time.

Single room supplement - Price: £280

If you are a single traveller, then we do need to add a single supplement charge (we do not share rooms on our Superior level Egyptian tours). This guarantees you a single room in the Cairo, Luxor & Hurghada hotels, and on the cruise boat, and also to a single cabin on the sleeper train.

Note: Couples will always be given a private double room. Triple rooms with 3 beds are not available, but twin & double rooms with connecting doors are available for family groups in the hotels.

Extra days - Price: subject to party make-up

These are available on request in Cairo before and after the main tour. If you want to add extra days into the time in Luxor or Hurghada, we can arrange this, but please request a tailor-

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made tour. The price includes a night in the 5-star hotel, breakfast, all taxes and transfers (single room supplements apply).

Cairo/Luxor flight option - Price: on request

The sleeper train timings fit in well with the tour, but if you do want to upgrade, this option provides an extra night in the hotel, all transfers, and an internal flight with Egypt Air instead of the train. Flights are subject to availability and prices are given on request.

Hurghada/Cairo flight option - Price: on request

This option provides an internal flight transfer back to Cairo from Hurghada, instead of the overland journey (approx. 6 hours). A wide range of times are available and all transfers are included.

Flights are subject to availability and prices are given on request.

Al Fayoum & Valley of the Whales - Price: see Options sheet

This option leaves Cairo in the morning of Day 9, and takes a private car/minibus or 4WD jeep via the Meidum Pyramid, one of the very first attempts at building a true pyramid, to the Fayoum area, about 90 minutes drive from Cairo. This extensively irrigated area is the most fertile region in Egypt and for centuries has supplied Egypt with wheat and numerous other crops. We stop to see the water wheels which have powered the irrigation for centuries, visit a natural spring, and see the Birket Qarn salt lake, home to many different birds including flamingos on one of the islands. We spend the night at a Bedouin style camp surrounded by the stunning desert & mountain scenery of Wadi Hitan (Valley of the Whales).

This World Heritage Site is accepted as the most significant site in the world to demonstrate the evolution of whales, and we take a 2-3km walk here the next morning to see several specimens of fossilised whales of different types sitting on the surface of the sand, as well as fossilised mangroves and the remains of crab holes. On the drive out of the desert, we stop at the Wadi Rayan Protected

Area, which surrounds a fresh-water lake in the middle of the desert, which is filled by the remaining irrigation water from the Fayoum area. There are several waterfalls here, and a bird hide which gives good views of the lakes birdlife, particularly in the winter months when the lake is an important stop for migrating water-birds. We also visit the Springs Oasis area, a rare example of an uninhabited Saharan oasis, and host to many different plants and animals, including Dorcas Gazelle, Ruppell's Sand Fox and Fennec Fox.

We return this evening to Cairo where we spend a night in a hotel before the tour finishes on Day 11 with a transfer to the airport for your departure.

Day 9 - Morning drive via Meidum pyramid to Fayoum and tour. Overnight at camp in Wadi Hitan (B).

Day 10 - Tour to the Valley of the Whales and Wadi Rayan. Drive back to Cairo. Overnight at hotel in Cairo (B L).

Day 11 - Cairo. Free time. Transfer to airport for departure. (B).

Pyramid view room upgrade - Price: £25 p/p

If you would like to upgrade your hotel room to one with a direct view of the pyramids, then you can add this option to your booking (subject to availability). The price covers your first night in Cairo.

Book in advance. Pay in advance.

B - OPTIONS AVAILABLE IN EGYPT

You will receive more information on all the options available to you while you are in Egypt in the Welcome Pack we provide on your arrival, together with information on how and when to book and pay for them with your guide or our local reps.

Prices are set in Egyptian Pounds but payments may also be made with hard currency (GB Pounds, Euros, US Dollars) at our local exchange rate at the time, which is set monthly. Credit card

payments are also accepted in Cairo for these payments (3% fee).

Hot air balloon flight - Price: see Options sheet

This runs early in the morning in Luxor, so that you catch the early morning sun while you float over the west bank of the Nile. The trip runs from between 5.00am and 10.00am (start times vary), with about 1 hour in the air. You do not miss out on any other activities.

There is a minimum number of people required for the trips to run, and they are also weather dependent. It is rare however that they are cancelled - if they are, a refund will be provided.

Note: Please remember to check that your travel insurance will cover hot air balloon flights. The balloon operators we suggest are fully licensed and insured - you may see cheaper options advertised locally which don't have all this cover in place.

Luxor temple at night - Price: see Options sheet

This short tour of Luxor temple in the middle of the town centre, runs in the early evening when the temples are beautifully lit up.

Sound & Light shows - Price: see Options sheet

These are available at the Pyramids in Cairo and Karnak Temple in Luxor. Prices include all transfers and your entrance ticket. Please check the start time for the English language show before booking as they can be very late.

Scuba-Diving option - Price: see Options sheet

There are a wide range of PADI diving courses for divers of all ages and levels of experience you can do during your time in Hurghada. Alternatively you can just try an introductory dive or two. These can all be arranged in advance or with our representatives in Hurghada. Extra days can be added into your time here if required.

ACCOMMODATION:

Our Superior level tours use high quality hotels, in which all rooms have air-conditioning, en-suite bathrooms, telephone and cable TV. Other facilities and services include swimming pools in pleasant garden surroundings, an assortment of coffee shops, cafes, restaurants and shops, fitness studio, business centre, laundry service and room service.

Notes:

- 5-star standards in Egypt may vary slightly from those in Western countries. However, we regularly inspect the hotels we use to ensure their high levels of facilities and service.
- Single, double & twin rooms are available on request. Triple rooms are not generally available. Connecting rooms are available for families in the hotels, but not on the cruise boats.
- At certain times of the year or where circumstances dictate we may

need to use different hotels from those listed below. In this event alternative hotels will always be of a similar standard.

- *If you are joining one of our group tours, or booking a private departure on the normal tour itinerary, then we will confirm your hotels about a week before departure. If you want to guarantee a stay in a particular hotel, then please request a tailor-made tour.*
- *On Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, the 5-star hotels in Egypt run a very special Gala Dinner. The cost of this is often compulsory, whether you attend or not, and is included in our group tour prices, and will be added to our private & tailor-made tour prices as required.*

Hotels used on this tour:

Wherever possible, we like to use a hotel in the pyramids area for your first stay in Cairo, and a city centre hotel for your second stay (subject to availability). We use the pyramid area for both stays from June to September during the Arab peak season when city centre hotels fill up extremely early.

Cairo (5-star):

- *Pyramids area - Oberoi Mena House, Le Meridien Pyramids, Sofitel Le Sphinx (on the outskirts of Cairo, by the pyramids).*
- *City centre - Cairo Marriott, Grand Hyatt, Semiramis*

Luxor (5-star):

- *Sonesta St. George, Steigenberger Nile Palace (formerly Le Meridien), Sheraton Luxor.*

Hurghada (5-star):

- *Marriott Resort or similar.*

TRANSPORT:

The transport used on this tour includes private AC minibuses, and the 1st Class overnight sleeper train. Most vehicles used are fitted with speed limiters and all are inspected & checked daily.

The sleeper train has private twin cabins with two seats and fold-down beds, storage space, and a sink with running water. A light airline style dinner & breakfast are included. Single cabins are available - see single supplement. Most pairs of cabins have a lockable connecting door.

TRANSFERS:

The tour includes a 24-hour airport meet & assist service in Cairo airport, your arrival and departure airport transfers and all other transfers.

INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS:

In order to keep our tours flexible, and to make them accessible to as many people as possible, we do not include your international flights in the set tour itinerary or price.

However, we do hold an ATOL (UK flight sales license) and are happy to book your flights for you. If you let us know your ideal dates and departure airport, then we will be happy to provide you with some flight options that we can arrange for you. You can then choose whether to book the flights through us, or make your own arrangements. Either way, your airport arrival & departure transfers are included.

TOUR LEADERS/GUIDES:

In order to provide the most personal service, and to make sure that you get as much out of our tours as possible, we like to keep our groups small. We therefore set the maximum number at 18 and the minimum at 2 people. You can join our group departures as an individual, couple, group of friends, or family.

For this tour we provide a fully trained, local English-speaking Egyptologist to act as your tour guide whilst you are in Egypt. He/she will be with you for all of the sightseeing tours in Cairo and the Nile Valley. Our local reps in all the towns and cities en-route are also at your service, and will be handling all the practical arrangements for the tour.

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For some private tours and groups of fewer than 4 people, we may use one guide in Cairo, and a second guide for the Aswan to Luxor section.

Our policy at Egypt Uncovered is to use only local guides and reps in Egypt, and for more details on our reasons for this please visit the 'Tour Type' page on our website.

ENTRANCE FEES:

The tour price includes entrance fees to all the sites mentioned in the itinerary. Entrance to the interior of the pyramids, and the mummy room in the Egyptian museum are not included, as the guides are not allowed in with you, and there are only limited tickets issued for the inside of the Great pyramid (allow approx. £12 for the mummy room, and £3-12 to go inside each of the pyramids).

In the Valley of the Kings, your entrance ticket covers 3 tombs. Extra tickets may be purchased locally to visit the tombs of Ramses V & VI (recommended, approx. £7 p/p) and of Tutankhamun (small tomb currently displaying the mummy of Tutankhamun, approx. £12 p/p).

COUNTRY GUIDE:

For an in-depth overview of Egypt, please checkout the country guide pages on our website.

DATES & PRICES:

We run regular small-group departures on this tour, normally every two weeks, throughout the year. These departure dates and prices are listed on our website and on a separate dates & prices sheet available on request. We can also run the set tour itinerary privately for you on other dates, or customise it to make a tailor-made tour to fit your personal requirements.

HEALTH:

For up to date health information & vaccination requirements for Egypt we recommend that you contact your GP or a travel clinic (1st Contact travel clinic gives free advice tel. 0800 0393073).

General vaccination recommendations for Egypt include Tetanus, Typhoid, Polio and Hepatitis A.

VISAS:

Many nationalities (including UK, USA, European, Australian, Canadian) can obtain their Egyptian visa on arrival in Cairo airport (cost US\$15 or equivalent). Our local representative will assist you with this process if possible. All African nationals will need to arrange their Egypt visa in advance.

RESPONSIBLE TOURISM:

We take responsible travel seriously, and as well as taking this into consideration when we design our itineraries, and select the people and agents we work with, we also donate £2 for every person travelling on of our Egyptian tours. This is split between two projects - the Dar Al Rahman orphanage in Cairo, and a desert clean-up project in Wadi Rayan, near Al Fayoum. You will have the chance to visit the orphanage if you wish during your time in Cairo, and if you would like to support either of these projects while you are in Egypt, you would be very welcome.

Full details of our responsible travel policy are given on our website.

PRE-DEPARTURE INFORMATION:

After booking, we will provide you with detailed information to help you prepare for the tour. This will include helpful advice on money, health, insurance, tipping, climate, clothing etc.

We also provide a Welcome Pack when you arrive in Egypt with more information including a tipping guide, local travel guide and an options information & booking sheet
