Detailed Itinerary

Cairo Pre-Tour Option

Day 1 Arrive in Sharm (Sunday for group departures)

You arrive at Sharm-el-Sheikh airport where we greet you and transfer you on the 1 ½ hour drive through the mountains to Dahab. Here, you check into your 2 star hotel, and our Egypt Uncovered rep welcomes you and lets you know the plan for the next few days.

The word Dahab in Arabic means gold and refers to the fine yellow sand that colours its beaches. The Bedouin village of Assalah lies along the shore of Ghazala Bay and is a collection of campsites, hotels, restaurants, shops and bars dotted with palm trees. It is here that you will experience the Bohemian feel that makes Dahab so special.

Overnight at 2 hotel in Dahab

Days 2 - 6 Introduction to Dive Centre, and start PADI Open Water course

On your first morning, we'll introduce you to the Dive centre, and explain what you will be doing over the next few days.

The Open Water Course is conducted over a 4 to 5-day period and, successful completion leads to full entry-level certification to the world of Scuba diving.

The course itself is broken down into three sections. These are (a) Confined water dives, of which you do 3, and which are usually done in a cordoned off beach area or a pool close to the beach (b) The theory section, which provides basic information and principles about diving, usually with the aid of videos along with a manual, and (c) At least 2 open water dives under qualified supervision and guidance.

During your confined water dives, you will complete your skills development sessions, which will include (but are not limited to): neutral buoyancy, mask

clearing, regulator removal / replacement, gear assembly/disassembly and storage, equalization, no-mask breathing, cramp removal, tired diver tow, no mask swim, alternate air source, stationary free flow regulator breathing, BC inflate, oral, removal and replacement of the scuba unit (u/w), removal and replacement of weight belt (u/w), removal and replacement of scuba unit (surface), removal and replacement of weight belt (surface), air depletion exercise.

The theory section (classroom sessions) is geared towards knowledge development, and will comprise of lectures, class participation and discussion. Students must successfully complete each section (module) before attempting the next module; there are 5 in total. There will be a final written exam. Most questions are either multiple choice or true/false. Your Open Water dives will give you the opportunity to demonstrate dive planning, practice, and evaluation.

The course is relaxed and designed to be a comprehensive learning experience to help you reach your goal of becoming a qualified diver. Our instructors are used to teaching a wide variety of people, and will tailor the way they teach the course to your personal needs and ability.

Day 7 Dahab – Free Day

Your last full day in Dahab is left free for you to relax.

2 Extra Dives Option

If you want to do some extra dives, then we can arrange these, within the restrictions of the 24 diving and flying rule.

Some of the best dive sites in the area include: A wall dive down to the Eel Gardens is a must for divers of all levels. Bottoming at fewer than 20m, there are few other sites that get you this close to Garden Eels in their natural habitat.

The Lighthouse offers a variety of routes, for all levels, and is especially popular as a night dive. This dive can be combined with a drift dive from the Eel Gardens.

The Fish Bowl is an enclosed circular cavern filled with small goldfish. Access is via beautiful coral gardens and there are several entrance/exit points, starting at 12-15m.

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The Islands is a collection of small islands that provide a maze of beautiful coral gardens. A max depth of approx 16m means plenty of sunlight and an unequalled diversity of marine life.

Drift dive along a coral wall at Rick's Reef and over the top of The Canyon. At only 20m (max) depth, this dive is suitable for all levels.

The experience of finning across the centre of the Blue Hole after a wall dive down to about 30m makes this site extremely popular. The Blue Hole is over 50m wide and 100m deep.

Cairo Post-Tour Option

Day 8 Dahab – Free Day

Your time is free this morning, until we transfer you back through the mountains to Sharm-el-Sheikh airport for your flight home.

Options

- Booking and Paying for Options:

All options should be booked in advance, when booking the tour. Spaces are left on the booking form to use for this purpose. You can also arrange extra dives with the dives school while you are there, subject to the availability of the local Dive Masters and Instructors.

Cairo Pre-Tour Option

If you want to visit Cairo during your trip to Egypt, or your flights will bring you into Cairo rather than Sharm-el-Sheikh, then we offer this option to add on to the start of our diving tours. This makes a 10 day tour altogether.

Book in advance. Pay in advance

Day 0 – Arrive in Cairo

You fly to Egypt on Saturday (for group departures), and are met at Cairo airport and transferred to a 2/3 star city centre hotel.

Overnight at hotel in Cairo

Day 1 – Cairo. Pyramids Tour

The following day (Sunday for group departures) we arrange a guided tour to visit the Pyramids and Sphinx at Giza and Saqqara.

In the evening you board the overnight public tourist coach to Dahab (approx. 8 hours). You are met on your arrival in

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Dahab on Monday morning, and transferred to your hotel. You now continue with the standard diving tour itinerary on Day 2.

Overnight on coach to Dahab (B)

Cairo Post-Tour Option

If you want to visit Cairo during your trip to Egypt, or your flights will leave from Cairo rather than Sharm-el-Sheikh, then we offer this option to add on to the end of our diving tours.

Book in advance. Pay in advance

Day 7 Dahab – Free day.

After your free day today, you leave this evening, and transfer you to Cairo on the overnight public tourist coach (approx. 8 hours).

Overnight on coach to Cairo (B)

Day 8 – Cairo. City Tour

You arrive in Cairo early this morning, and we transfer you to a 2/3 star hotel in the city centre. During the day, we arrange a full day guided tour of the city of Cairo, visiting the famous Egyptian museum, the Citadel, mosques, and the Khan-el-Khalili bazaar.

In the evening we take you on a 2-hour sunset felucca cruise on the Nile.

Overnight at hotel in Cairo (B)

Day 9 – Cairo. Transfer to airport

Your tour ends this next morning, and we transfer you to Cairo airport for your departure.

2 Extra Dives

This option adds 2 extra dives into your tour, to be arranged on your free day in Dahab on Day 7. You can arrange exactly when and where to take these dives with the dive school while you are in Egypt.

We can also offer more extra dives if required – please contact us for more details and prices.

When you are booking dive(s) and diving courses in advance, you should consider the possibility that you might not elect (for whatever reason) to use one or more of those dives. Dives are strictly non-transferable, and no refund would be issued if you did not use up all your dives. In the eventuality of a diving problem occurring whilst on one of our dive packages or courses, no refund will be issued.

PADI Course Manuals

From the 1st January 2006, dive-centres are no longer allowed to provide course manuals for you just for the duration of the course. You now need to purchase your own, and keep it with you when you go home. This cost is normally paid locally unless we specify that it is included in the tour price. The Open Water Course manual is GBP30 p/p

Extra Dives

We cannot guarantee that all of the options on approved diving courses (i.e. the adventure dives you do as part of your Advanced Open Water) will always be available. Changes will occur (subject to availability) and are entirely at the Dive Centre's (School's) discretion. Also, we cannot confirm where you will do any 'Extra Dives' that you book. The Dive Centre will endeavour to satisfy customers where possible, but it is entirely at the Dive Centre's (School's) discretion, and local diving conditions at the time.

Accommodation

Our standard diving tours use good quality hotels (approx. 2/3 star) in which all rooms have air-conditioning and en-suite bathrooms. The hotel in Dahab has a swimming pool, and is located around 300m from the sea, and 400m from the Dive School.

At certain times of the year or where circumstances dictate we may need to use different hotels from the ones listed above.

In this event alternative hotels will always be of a similar standard.

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Transport

We provide a private transfer by air-conditioned car, minivan or minibus between Sharm-el-Sheikh airport and Dahab, and for any sightseeing tours in Cairo. The optional journey to and from Cairo is done using an air-conditioned public tourist coach.

Meals

We include breakfasts only in our diving tours in Egypt. This is because you will need to start relatively early, and we have found it more convenient for you to take breakfast in the hotel.

The opportunities for eating out for lunch and dinner in Dahab are extensive, cheap, and of good quality – many people find that the food here is one of the highlights of their stay.

Transfers

All our tours include a 24-hour meet & greet and hotel transfer service in Sharm-el-Sheikh or Cairo airport.

Your tour also includes all other transfers. Our representative will meet you after you go through Passport Control in Sharm-el-Sheikh airport, and transfer you straight to your hotel (approx. 1 1/2 hours)

If you are flying into Cairo, then our representative will meet you in the immigration hall, before you go through passport control. He/she will help you with your visas, and then take you straight to your hotel (about 30 mins)

Group Sizes & Tour Leaders/Guides

In order to provide the most personal service, and to make sure that you get as much out of our diving tours as possible, we like to keep our groups small. We therefore set the maximum number at 8 and the minimum at 2 people.

Our local reps in all the towns and cities en-route are also at your service.

Our policy at Egypt Uncovered is to use only local guides and tour leaders where possible and for more details on our reasons for this please visit the 'Tour Class' page on our website.

There still aren't enough qualified Egyptian diving instructors to go around however, so when we do use Western instructors, these will have worked in Dahab for some time, and know the country and surrounding dive sites well.

Health

For up to the minute health information & vaccination requirements for Egypt we recommend that you contact your GP or a travel clinic (1st Contact have a travel clinic with free advice tel. 0800 0393073). General vaccination recommendations for Egypt include Tetanus, Typhoid, Polio and Hepatitis A.

Scuba-diving has its own special considerations with regard to your health. Please ensure you read the medical information on our website relating to scuba-diving. We will also send you a copy of the standard PADI medical questionnaire after you have booked, which you will need to complete before you start any diving.

Visas

British, European, and many other nationalities can obtain their Egyptian visa on arrival in Cairo airport (cost US\$15). All African nationals will need to arrange their visa in advance.
