Masada & Dead Sea tour

This option leaves Tel Aviv via the Judean hills to visit the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth. Here we stop at a Dead Sea cosmetic shop, where you can find many products made from the mineral rich local mud. We take a drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to ancient Masada. We climb aboard a cable car to reach the mountain fortress built by King Herod. Here we visit the remains of the walls, palace, synagogue, water cisterns, mosaic floors, roman baths and other findings, and learn about how the Zealots of the first century made their last stand against the Romans. We continue to the Dead Sea, where you can enjoy a unique opportunity to float in the Dead Sea and perhaps cover yourself with the mineral rich mud that many believe has therapeutic effects.

Jerusalem & Bethlehem tour

This option start with a drive to the Mount of Olives for a spectacular panoramic view of the city. We then head to Mount Zion to visit King David's Tomb, Room of Last Supper and the Dormition Abbey. We next enter the Old City and take a stroll through the Armenian and Jewish quarters to the recently excavated and restored Cardo, the Roman road. Our next stop is to visit the Jewish Wailing Wall, the Kotel, and then continue on to the Christian quarter, where we walk along the Via Dolorosa and visit the Church of Holy Sepulchre.

Our final visit takes us to Bethlehem where Jesus was born, and we'll take a walk through the Manger square to visit the Church of Nativity, and view the Shepherds' field.

This Tel Aviv City tour option start with a visit to the Diaspora museum, followed with a drive through the main streets of Tel-Aviv, centre of business & entertainment of Israel. Tel Aviv is also known as the "White City", and was declared by UNESCO as a world cultural heritage site for its Bauhaus style buildings.

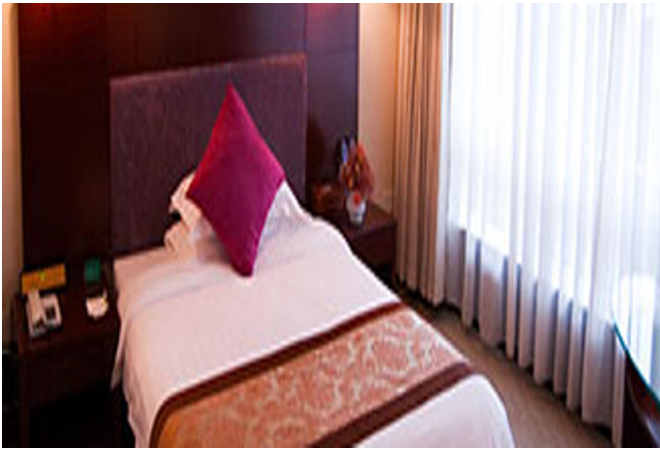
Next we stop at Rabin Square, which is the place that Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin was assassinated. We then continue to Old Jaffa, one of the oldest port cities in the world, where we visit the ancient ruins and walk along the Artist's Quarter.

Fron Jaffa, we head across to Neve Tzedek, the first neighborhood of Tel Aviv, built in 1887 and Nahalat Benyamin, the pedestrian mall of the city. Here you can enjoy live street music, arts, crafts and handmade jewelry.

Our final stop is to Sheinkin, a lively and colorful street specially known for its unique shops, cafe life and youthful ambiance.
